Celebrating the hairless head

All exhibition proceeds to Cancer Research


One in two Australians will be diagnosed with cancer by the age of 85. The risk of being diagnosed with breast cancer by age 85 is one in eight for women, one in 721 for men.

Deb Rielly, was one of them.

The popular Wonthaggi paramedic, triathlete, tireless volunteer and charity fundraiser, Bass Coast Shire Citizen of the Year 2019 and mother of 19-year-old twin sons, lost her battle with cancer after a 15-year fight just six months ago. During that 15 years she lost her hair through chemotherapy treatment and faced taunts as she refused to wear a wig or a scarf. She became the inspiration for a unique art exhibition staged by ArtSpace which celebrated the hairless head.

The inaugural exhibition in May of this year and part of Creative Gippsland was a great success with paintings, prints, drawings and sculptures all being represented. So great a success that a book is now published and will be launched at ArtSpace this weekend.

The judge, internationally renowned artist, Dr Tony Hanning said of the exhibition, "The quality of the work was outstanding. Some of it was extremely clever, demonstrating exceptional painting and drawing skills while some of it was more deliberated and worked but in both cases excellence was the final outcome."





All proceeds go to the Cancer Council. "Deb's incredible courage has inspired us to come together as a community in Gippsland to raise funds to make cancer a disease of the past," said ArtSpace President and organiser of the event, Liane Arno.

Next year will follow a similar theme to this year's with a special preview of artworks at the Wonthaggi Town Hall in conjunction with the Cancer Council's Biggest Morning Tea on May 20th. One volunteer, Helen Laing has been running these morning teas for 20 years – so it promises to be very special.





CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

We will accept online entry only.

All exhibits must be the original work of the exhibitor and must not have been entered into Ficifolia Art Show previously.

All exhibits must be for genuine sale with the exemptions of Primary/Secondary student's exhibits. Your entry must be received by Midnight Friday January 31st 2020. No late entries will be accepted.

- · Each work is eligible for one prize only, with the judges' decision being final. (Peoples choice award exempt). Awards are non-acquisitive unless otherwise stated.
- · Limit of 3 entries per person.
- 2D ARTWORKS Unless suitably and securely wired for hanging, entries will not necessarily be accepted. Maximum size accepted is 1.3mts in any direction including frame.
- . 3D ARTWORKS must be able to be moved into and out of exhibition space by one person Maximum size accepted is 1.3M width by 2.2mtrs height. (Footprint no greater than 1.3M)
- · SMALL WORKS maximum of 22cm in any direction which includes any frame.
- . Artist's name, Title of work and Price must be attached to the back or underside of each exhibit entered.
- The Committee reserves the right to use any artwork for promotional purposes.
- · All reasonable care will be taken with artworks, but artists are responsible for their own
- All entries will be seen by the selection panel and will be hung at the organisers discre-tion, dependant upon space available.
- Payment of prizes and sales will be by direct credit. Please bring bank details for Treasurer when delivering your work
- · Finalists will be advised after the judging on the afternoon of Wednesday February 5th.





Hello ...

We are calling for entries to A4 Art Australia, an initiative and exhibition opportunity from The Contemporary Art Society of Victoria.

What is A4 Art Australia?

A4 Art Australia is an exhibition of 2D and 3D A4-sized artworks, hence the title. This exhibition will showcase A4-sized artworks by both established and emerging artists and offers all participating artists the opportunity gain exposure for their art at low entry cost. By having a format of A4-sized artworks, artists from all over Australia have an opportunity to conveniently submit works via Australia Post. All selected 2D artworks will be framed by us for the exhibition (see conditions) and entry is only \$13 per artwork. We will also accept appropriately-sized 3D (sculptural) works for this exhibition - see our online FAQ for more information about artwork size requirements.

Contemporary artists are invited to submit up to four (4) A4-sized artworks for the exhibition.

A4 Art Australia is run by the Contemporary Art Society of Victoria Inc. The Society is a non-profit organisation, run on a voluntary basis by artists for the benefit of artists and those interested in the arts. It is based in Melbourne, Victoria, Australia, and was founded in 1938.

A4 Art Australia will be held in the Gallery on Herring Island (Richmond) as part of the Herring Island Summer Arts Festival 2020. Herring Island is a unique island in the middle of the Yarra River, between Richmond and South Yarra, only 3km

from the Melbourne CBD. The festival website is HERE.

The exhibition (and gallery) will be open to the public 11.30am – 4.30pm on the following dates: 14, 15, 21, 22, 27, 28, 29 MARCH and 4, 6, 10, 11, 12, 13 April 2020.

Entry cost: Entry is AU\$13 per work.

Plus a fixed \$10 postage charge for return of your unsold works (refundable if you sell all your work).

Additional size/weight-related postage charges apply for 3D works.

Note: Entry fees can be paid by PayPal / cheque / money order / credit card / EFT.

How to enter: ENTER ONLINE via our website.

Deadline: Completed entry form, with correct payment together with your 2 dimensional art works, by 28 February 2019. (see conditions of entry)
